



# Dishwasher loading instructions and racks provided

### Upper rack:

## Fold down glass holder (A):

Depending on the position, for example small or longstemmed glasses.

#### Crockery holders (B):

Depending on the position, for example plates, cups and long-stemmed glasses.

#### Half Load: If the upper rack only is to be loaded, place the cutlery basket (C) in the upper rack.

### Rack height adjustment (also when loaded):

Upper adjustment:

Pull the **two** rack handles (**D**) outwards and lower the rack. Pull the **two** rack handles (**D**) upwards until the rack clicks into place (factory setting).

The rack must be level on both sides.

#### Lower rack:

Plate holders (E).

#### Half load:

Load the lower rack only. Greater washing power, particularly for plates and saucepans.


## Cutlery basket (F):


Some models are provided with a grid **(G)** that can be fitted onto the cutlery basket to keep items separate.


Cutlery basket (C) for half loads.


Sharp knives and forks that might cause injury must be placed in the cutlery basket with the handles positioned upwards.


Only use dishwasher-proof crockery and dishes. Do not use the appliance for items not suitable for washing in a dishwasher, for example wooden items, aluminium, plastic utensils, tin, hand-decorated crockery (unglazed), silver cutlery.

# What to do if...

If a fault occurs, before contacting our After-Sales Service, make the following checks to try and remedy the problem (\* see also the corresponding chapter in the user instructions).

Problem	Cause	Remedy
The appliance is not working	No water supply.	Open the tap.
	The appliance does not load sufficient water.	<ul><li>Clean the water supply tap filter.</li><li>Ensure there are no kinks in the water hose.</li></ul>
	There is a power failure.	<ul><li>Insert the plug into the mains socket.</li><li>Press the Start button.</li><li>Close the door.</li><li>Check the domestic circuit fuse.</li></ul>
	Starting the selected programme.	• The programme can be set to "0" to start.
If crockery is not perfectly dry	Insufficient rinse aid.	Increase dosage *.
	Residual water in cavities.	Load crockery at an angle.
If crockery is not perfectly clean	The water jet does not reach the crockery.	<ul> <li>Arrange crockery so that items do not touch each other. Load crockery upside down.</li> </ul>
	Insufficient detergent.	Follow recommended detergent dosage.
	<ul><li>Unsuitable programme.</li><li>Spray arms blocked.</li></ul>	<ul><li>Select a more intense wash cycle.</li><li>The spray arms must be able to turn freely.</li></ul>
	<ul> <li>Spray arm nozzles clogged.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Remove any impurities obstructing the water flow *.</li> </ul>
	Incorrect detergent/detergent too old.	Use a good quality detergent.
Sandy or grainy residues	<ul><li>Clogged filters.</li><li>Filters incorrectly assembled.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Check filters regularly/if necessary clean *.</li> <li>Insert the filter correctly *.</li> </ul>
Colour of plastic parts faded	Tomato/carrot juice,	• Depending on the material, if necessary use a detergent with a greater whitening power.

removable	Streaks on the crockery/glasses.	Increase the rinse aid dosage *.
	<ul><li>Streaks on glasses.</li><li>Layer of salt on crockery/glasses.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Reduce the rinse aid dosage *.</li> <li>Close the salt container lid properly *.</li> </ul>
not removable	<ul> <li>Layer of sair of clocker ygasses.</li> <li>Insufficient water softening, calcium deposits.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Change water hardness setting, if necessary add salt *.</li> </ul>
Opaque glasses/ glasses not sparkling	• Cannot be washed in the dishwasher.	Use suitable glasses.
Rust on cutlery	Not made of stainless steel.	Use suitable cutlery.
Identifying appliance faults	The START indicator lamp flashes.	• Ensure that the filter assembly is not clogged and if necessary clean it *. Start the programme again. Press the Start button for 2 seconds, until the Start indicator lamp switches off. Select a new programme and press the Start button again.
	Indicator F (if provided).	Call the After-Sales Service.

If after carrying out the above checks the malfunction persists or appears again, turn the appliance off and turn off the water supply tap, then call our After-Sales Service (see guarantee).

Before contacting our After-Sales Service, take note of the following:

- The nature of the fault.
- The appliance type and model.
- The service code (the number indicated on the adhesive rating plate) inside the door on the right-hand side.
